
Beginning Monday March 16, our physical offices in Darlington and Dodgeville will be closed, with plans to reopen on Monday, July 6th by appointment only.

Survivor Services

Periods of crisis like this can be particularly unsafe for survivors, some of whom may be forced into close contact with an abusive partner, and many will face additional financial hardships. During this time, our team will be offering phone-based support to new and existing survivors including advocacy, counseling, legal and medical advocacy. The team will have uninterrupted access to email and voicemail while working remotely during regular business hours.


